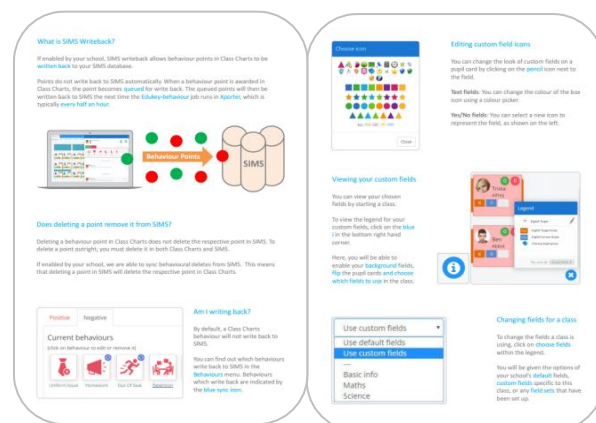
Knowledgebase
