Getting started with Class Charts

Class Charts is an online behaviour management platform that allows teachers to manage their seating plans, monitor in-class behaviour, set and collect homework tasks and so much more.

This quick start guide will show you how to set up Class Charts login portals for teachers, parents and pupils on your school website.

Depending on the Class Charts license that your school has purchased, this guide will also show you how to display a homework calendar through your school website.

If you are unsure on which license type you are using, please check with the main school admin on your school's Class Charts account.





You can boost Class Charts' usage at your school even further by adding a shortcut to Class Charts on your school's computer desktops. Follow the steps below to create a shortcut using Google Chrome.

1. Click on the three dots menu in the top right hand corner of your Chrome browser.



2. Mouse over the More tools option in the drop down menu and select Create shortcut.
